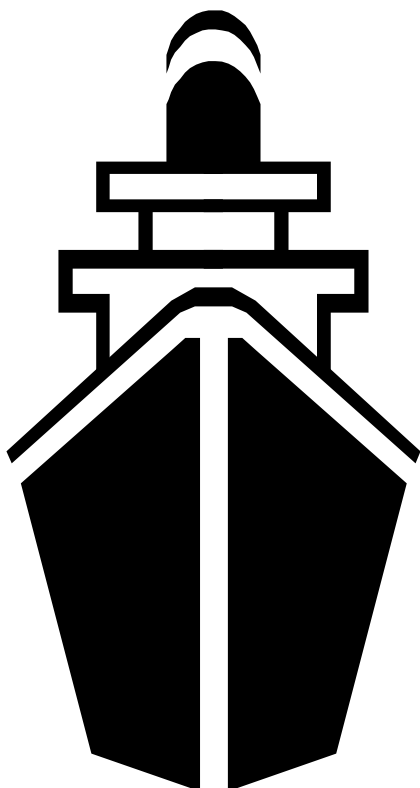


Australasian and Indo-Pacific Neighbours Network – Training

The Floating University 2005 Research Cruise



Call for Participants:

Students who are undertaking postgraduate studies in the marine sciences, or who are interested in doing so, are invited to apply for a place on our upcoming Research Cruise.

Dates: 31 July to 7 August 2005, plus a five day post-cruise workshop.

Location: Between Darwin and Djakarta (or nearby port).

The Course:

Students will conduct research under the guidance of local experts. They will participate in onboard lectures, tutorials and e-learning modules. The course will cover aspects of marine geology, oceanography and biology.

Costs:

The Asian Neighbours Network TTR programme will pay most costs associated with transport to and from the ship and accommodation while in transit. Accommodation and living expenses during the cruise will also be covered. Passports, visas, medical examinations, travel insurance and incidental charges are the responsibility of individual applicants.

Application Information:
